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#### 1.INTRODUCTION:

The Institute of Complementary Medicine and Research Trust(ICMR TRUST) registered under Indian Trust Act, was established to promote health care through complementary healing systems and developing human resource in the field of medicine and health care. It has been providing its services since 2008 in the district of Koraput, one of the most backward and poor districts of Odisha, India.

The Trust started its service activities since then by providing medical, surgical and homoeopathic treatment, through its health centre and mobile health unit in different villages. It works for integrated development of children, youth, women, marginazed people and People with Disability in mainstreaming and who is in need of better health care and education. Alternatively in supports their livelihood and development.

We at ICMRTrust, facilitating quality education and health care in need, which are priority for us. Establishment of **Anandam Kids School** at Village Dumuriput, Dist-Koraput is an initiative towards providing quality education within reach of poor and marginalized rural children. Establishment of **VI (Visual Impaired) Girls Children's Home** is another step towards mainstreaming PwD (VI) in education and Development. The Total Blind Girl Brunda Bhoi is the first Visual Impaired tribal poor girl, who is reading now in class I and completed training DLS (Daily Living Skill) and O & M (Orientation and Mobility) as per need and staying in our **BALA ASHRAM**.

#### 2. ORGANISATION:

#### Genesis:

A Thinker and social Activist who is highly sensitive towards the cause of disparity, poverty and exploitation, by profession a doctor, deserted his comfortable lifestyle and turned towards exploring way to establish a society, where there is no one remains hungry, discriminated or exploited. By Finding out his two similar friends an engineer and a sociology graduate whose thinking also same and established ICMRTrust in the year 2008 with mentor and guide, a great philosopher and socio spiritual activist of India, who profound **NEOHUMANISM** and exploring his vision in almost all countries of the world, **Shrii Prabhat Ranjan Sarkar.**Once he commented to provide all round services in this area. So we initiated our work in this area.

#### 3. ACTIVITIES:

## **Programmes**

## i) Education:-

#### **Anandam Kids School:**

We started this school in view of low cost quality schooling in this area with coeducation, Odiya and English from play way method (Nursery). This session year 1015-16, Anandam applied for recognisation to concerned authority of state Government and getting recognisation and DISE Number. Children from surrounding villages getting quality education. We adopting Neohumanistic model education and rational view for castles society. Our teacher student ratio is 1:10. Now it's the first private school included, inclusive education and admitted VI children with sighted children by providing friendly atmosphere for PwD (VIC). The school was inaugurated in presence of SSEPD-Koraput, NAB(I)-Vice President and NAB(O)- secretary on 31st March 2016.







# ii) Health:-

#### **ICMR Institute:**

- This Institute is promoting paramedical sciences and complementary medical Education.
- 30 girls get skill Development Training on Basic Nursing Assistant, Laboratory Technique.
- 4 candidates get assistance for placement.
- Four persons also completed professional Diploma on complementary healing system, now helping people and doing their own professional practice.





#### ANANDA NIKETAN VISION CENTRE:

- Village based eye health services (with free/subsidized) for once in every month at Centre Dumuriput, Koraput district.
- 676 OPD, 521 refraction, 30 power spectacles and medicines were provided (60% free and 40% subsidized) for needy eye patients.

#### ANANDA NIKETAN MEDICAL CENTRE:

- Village based rural health care centre with OPD, Pathology, Pharmacy and causality services through complementary medicine and allopathic medicine in emergency at Centre Dumuriput, Koraput district.
- 2021 OPD, 500 causalities& emergencies with medicine and 1010 pathological diagnostic test support provided (40% free and 60% subsidized) for needy patients.





#### ANANDA NIKETAN MOBLE HEALTH SERVISES:

- Team of Paramedics rendering health service to needy, in unreachable area and strengthening governments' public health system every month through awareness campaigning.
- 15 health camps, 20 awareness meeting on complete immunization, eye care and healthy nutrition were organized.
- 1130 people getting benefited and accessed their needy service provided by the government.

## iii) PwD Welfare and Development:

#### BALAA ASHRAM (Hostel for VI Girls):

The Girls education is very poor, female literacy rate 38.92 only and Visual Impaired girls from outreach pockets of koraput district are most neglected. So, we started a hostel for them, from session 2016-17. So for minimum necessary of 10 bedded 800square building is under construction. It will costs around sum of Rs.8, 40,000(eight lahks and forty thousand) only.

## iv) Other Events:

**Skill Development Training for Visual Impaired Children**-30 VI children participated for 7 days on skill development programme on O&M,DLS,Braille and curricular activities with support of NAB, India, Mumbai and well wishers,koraput.

**Children Resource Centre-**A children resource centre was developed on memory of late Sri Balaji Panigrahi, where both sighted and Visual impaired children can access their services, by support of some students of social activist and advocate Sri Balaji Panigrahi.

**Strengthening government's inclusive education model**-Identifying 100 VI children, now supporting 31 VI children in 27 schools on their study through our Itinerant Teachers with support of NAB. Parents and teachers meeting were organized on inclusive education and skill transfer and support.

**Banishree Scholarship**- Awareness campaigning and support organized to release the Banishree scholar ship.30 Disable children get benefitted.

**Braille Kit Distribution**-30 Braille Kits Distributed to VI Children for their educational support.

**Meeting on Communal Harmony**-Awareness campaigning among the students was organized on communal harmony day.

World Disable day, World AIDS Day, World Health Day and World sights Day, White cane day was observed and awareness was organized among public.

#### 4. SUCCESS STORY:

# Mainstreaming Sasmita Bagh, Visual Impaired Girl

**Sasmita Bagh** is 12 years old daughter of Mrs.Sabitri and Mr.Pitabash Bagh lives at Kalahandi colony (Slum) of Damanjodi area in koraput block. Parents are daily laborers and went daily for work by closing her in their house. She is Total blind by birth and limited mobility in her house before intervention. She was unable to move and in active of daily life. We intervened with our special educator.

We initiating her on ADL, mobility, fine/gross motor development, social behavior and then provided Braille kit for her education intervention. Organizing training to her parents on ADL and skill transfer to watch her development every day. Also she was linked to government pension plan after certification. All these have contributed to take care of her. Now she improved her fine motor and postures. She tries to hold stylus and writes, eats, addresses family members .Doing her all ADL activities and attending nearby government school and getting escort allowance for her regular school.Samita loves music and dance now a days. She is mainstreaming now as possible.
